#### RESETTLEMENT ACTION PLAN (RAP) FOR NEAMATI TERMINAL

The Resettlement Action Plan (RAP) for the project have been guided by the existing legislation and policies of the Government of India and World Bank's Safeguard OP

4.12. Prior to the preparation of the RAP, a detailed analysis of the existing national and state policies was undertaken and a Resettlement Policy Framework (RPF) has been prepared and approved for the entire AIWTD project

#### 1. Need for Resettlement Action Plan

- To identify adverse impacts and determine mitigation measures;
- To present the entitlements and action plan for the affected persons for payment of compensation and assistance for restoring livelihoods, and improving or at least retaining the existing living standards.
- Facilitate the design of a monitoring program to check the adequacy and implementation of mitigate measures.

#### 2. Approach and Methodology

The RAP has been based largely on primary data collected during joint field survey conducted on 13th April & 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023. The field research includes preliminary social survey of the Project Affected Persons (PAPs) and properties within the selected Neamati terminal site. The methodology used for preparation of RAP is discussed below:

- Socio-economic Survey: Socio-economic survey was conducted for each structure and properties covering owners and squatter. This survey was conducted assess the extent of impacts due to proposed upgrading of terminal. A joint survey was conducted on 13<sup>th</sup> April 2023 by AIWTDS Officials along with Revenue Officials of Jorhat District Administration. A final field survey was undertaken on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023 by Revenue Officials with AIWTDS Officials to finalise the number of squatters in the proposed project site.
- Consultations: Consultations with potential project affected persons and local people were conducted to inform the people about the proposed up gradation and improvement of the terminal and also to understand perceptions and suggestions by them in the presence of Revenue Officials, AIWTDS Officials and Gaon Panchayat Officials on 19th July 2023 at 35 no. Gaon Panchayat Office.

#### 3. Impacts of the Proposed Project

The up gradation works of the terminal will be mostly on riverine side which are mainly floating components. About 26505 sq. mtr needs to be acquired for the proposed terminal up gradation is submerged private land wherein NoC has been acquired from the O/O the District Administration for the entire area against compensation for the loss of land Ownership and livelihood.

#### 3.1 Impacts on Land

The existing Neamati terminal is the most important ferry terminal for the residents travelling from Jorhat to Majuli. On interaction with IWT officials it was shared that during monsoon season which generally falls from the month of June till September, the terminals needs to be shifted from one place to another due to fluctuating water level of the river which causes inconvenience to the commuters as well as to the ferry operators. The land near the proposed terminal gets submerged during monsoon and barren when water level of the river declines.

The land requirement for terminal as per DPR is given in Table-1.0.

As per approved RPF by World Bank for this project the process flow for Land Acquisition and R&R is well defined. This process includes Requisition of Land by AIWTDS. The proposal for acquisition of any private land has been made in the formats prescribed by the enacted rules of the Assam State Government on the RFCTLARR 2015 under the RFCTLARR, 2013 of Government of India. These formats include Khasra maps, along with the details of area of land to be acquired. The process also emphasises Appointment of "Administrator" for R&R, Notification, Declaration and Preparation of Award.

The Neamati Ghat is proposed on submerged private land. AIWTDS has submitted a proposal to Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat for acquisition of land at Kumargaon village under Hezari Mauza of Jorhat West Revenue Circle for the development of Ferry Terminal at Neamati Ferry Ghat. After site inspection and ground verification, Revenue Department issued a general notice in accordance with the Govt. Notification No. RLA. 177/2021/3 on 20.02.2023 to register objections/claim, if any, within 30 days of the publication of notice. The same was also published in two daily newspapers namely 'The Assam Tribune' and 'The Dainik Janmbhumi' on 21.02.2023 (*Annexure - 1 B*). District Revenue Department has calculated an estimate of Rs.1,28,98,881.88 (Rupees One Crore Twenty Eight lakhs Ninety Eight thousand Eight Hundred Eighty One and Eighty Eight paisa) only for the compensation of land and the squatters that fall within the land and requested to deposit the same to district revenue Department. Initially, as per the Letter No. JRA. 129/2022 dated 29.03.2023, no objection/claim was received from any interested party/person.

However, a general meeting was held with Circle Officer of West Revenue Circle, Jorhat; GP President of 35 no GP; Gaon Pradhan of 35 no GP; GP Secretary of 35 no GP; Junior Engineer of IWT; Supervisor Kanungo of L A Branch, DC Office; Supervisor Kanungo of Jorhat West Circle; Lat Mandal of Jorhat West Circle, Land Revenue Assistant of LA Branch and AIWTDS Social Development Experts along with the available Pattadars of the land and Possessors of the shops at Neamati Ghat on 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 in the 35 no Gaon Panchayat Office premises regarding settlement of issues on land acquisition (*Annexure - 1 C*). After the meeting a letter from the Addl. Deputy Commissioner (LA) (*Annexure - 1 D*), Jorhat was received stating that as per the report from the Circle officer, Pattadars of 5 numbers of dag have already communicated and process is already initiated to communicate with the pattadars of rest 4 numbers of dag out of total 9 numbers of dag which falls under the proposed acquisition. In addition to the stated Pattadars, 6 numbers of possessors/squatters have also been identified. The Land Related Public Notificationand other related documents have been enclosed within *Annexure-I* 

#### 3.2 Impacts on Livelihood

A socio-economic survey was conducted by the AIWTDS to identify the Project Affected Persons (PAPs) and make the inventory of the assets and structure to be impacted. The cut out date for identification at proposed Neamati Terminal up gradation site was 09.06.2023. According to the survey at proposed project location it was recorded that 06 squatters along the existing approach road and in the submerged land which gets barren after water level of river declines will be affected and their structures have to be removed from the site. The details are given in Table 2.0

Thus, there are 06 squatters whose livelihood will be effected. The detailed information about the squatters like type of structures, socio-economic profile, family details, ownership of assets and livelihood restoration preferences etc. was collected during the survey. The details are presented in following sections

#### 3.2.1 Typology of the Structure

The structures owned by the squatters are tin sheds and can be categorised as temporary structures.

#### 3.2.2 Socio-Economic Profile of the Squatters

The brief socio-economic aspects of the squatters has been presented in this section. The detailed data recorded and compiled from census survey carried out in the month of April, 2023. The recorded data format of the squatters is enclosed as **Annexure-I (F)**.

#### 3.2.4 Ownership of Assets

It is well documented that all the respondents do not own any of the assets like agriculture land, orchards, livestock, four wheelers etc. However, all are using mobile phones and few ofthem possesses bicycles, television, fridge and motor bikes etc.

#### 3.2.5 Livelihood Restoration Preference

The livelihood restoration preferences as discussed and recorded during socioeconomic survey and interaction with PAPs is summarised as below. It was recorded that all the affected persons expressed the need for the compensation for loss of livelihood as per the R&R plan of the project.

#### 5. Stakeholder Engagement:

A general meeting was held with the Pattadars of the land and Possessors (squatters) of the shops in the presence of Circle Officer of West Revenue Circle, Jorhat, GP President, Gaon Pradhan, GP Secretary, Junior Engineer of IWT, Supervisor Kanungo of L A Branch, DC Office, Supervisor Kanungo of Jorhat West Circle, Lat Mandal of Jorhat West Circle, Land Revenue Assistant of LA Branch and AlWTDS Officials- Social Development Experts at Neamati Ghat on 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 in the 35 no Gaon Panchayat Office premises regarding settlement of issues on land acquisition of Neamati Ghat for construction of Neamati passenger ferry terminal.

The meeting started with a general introduction of the Revenue Officials and AIWTDS Social Team with the Four Pattadars and Six Possessors that were present in the meeting. It was followed by a general discussion upon the importance of the terminal construction at Neamati Ghat.

After discussion amongst the members present, the following issues were noted:

- 1. While 9 Pattadars are given in the L A estimate provided by Jorhat DC Office, Pattadars for 4 Dag Numbers were only present. Instead of the original Pattadars mentioned in the LA estimate, their descendants (sons and grandsons) represented the original Pattadars as they are no more alive.
- 2. The available documents carried by the descendants proving their lineage and connection with their original Pattadars were duly checked by the LA branch officials and found to be authentic in presence of Circle Officer and all other Officials present.
- 3. The Six possessors mentioned in the LA Estimate were present and also duly checked by aforementioned Officials.
- 4. Of Six Possessors, two Possessors viz. Kunju Hazarika and Horulora Das in the LA Estimate have expressed certain discrepancies in their names mentioned in the LA Estimate.
  - In case of Kunju Hazarika, she claims her name in the identification document is Jumi Hazarika and her pet name is actually Kunju which by mistake was given when the Revenue officials visited.
  - In case of Horulora Das, the error is regarding one letter only and he claims his name in the identification document is Sarulora Das.

Both of them were advised by the Revenue Officials to get affidavit done to prove the same.

- 5. Revenue officials informed the Social team of the Society that one Pattadar could not come to the meeting due to some unavoidable circumstances and he was informed by the officials to visit the Circle Office later as per his convenience.
- 6. In the end of the meeting the Social team of the Society requested the Pattadars and LA estimate team to try to reach out the rest of the Pattadars who were not present in the meeting at the earliest.

#### 6. Grievance Redressal Mechanism:

To resolve the complaints related to issues as part of the project AIWTDS has already formulated Grievance Redressal Mechanisms (GRM). The PIU has already communicated on the GRM mechanism to the PAPs during the general consultation meet.

#### 8. Monitoring:

- On 19th July'23 during the consultation with the Pattadars and Possessors (Squatters), AIWTDS officials in the presence of LA branch, DC Office, Jorhat have reviewed the identity of the Pattadars and Possessors (Squatters) to check and establish their authenticity of claim.
- AIWTDS officials have also made a progress in supporting the Revenue Officials
  to identify the claimants while they have not come on their own even with proper
  publications in two leading newspapers inviting claims.
- With successful efforts made to identify the claimants, the next step is to ensure proper disbursal to respective claimants by the Jorhat District Administration.
- In this regard a meeting with the DLPCC will be conducted before the disbursal.
- AIWTDS will ensure obtaining the Utilization Certificate (UC) after disbursal of the entire amount to the PAPs.

#### 10. Implementation and Procedure for RAP

The procedure to be adopted for implementation of RAP based on approved RPF forthis project is described in following paragraphs.

#### a. Appointment of Administrator

In pursuance of the Government Gazette Notification no RLA. 177/2021/3 dated 07/03/2022 the District Level Land Purchase Committee, Jorhat was constituted (Annexure – 1 G) for thepurpose of Land Acquisition through direct purchase policy as well as fixation of market valuein acquisition of land and for implementation of R & R activities as per the RPF approved for the project for construction of passenger ferry terminal at Neamati Ferry Ghat in Jorhat district at Village Kumargaon under Hazari Mouza of Jorhat west Revenue Circle comprising of the following officials-

- The Deputy Commissioner, Jorhat as the Chairman
- The Addl. Deputy Commissioner (LA), Jorhat as Member Secretary
- The State Project Director, AIWTDS as Member
- The Circle Officer, Jorhat West Revenue Circle as Member
- The Executive Engineer, IWTD, Jorhat Division as Member
- The Sr. Sub Registrar, Jorhat as Member.

#### b. Notification, Declaration and Preparation of Award

The R&R awardee list and scheme was prepared on the basis of the survey and valuation of assets of PAPs. The R&R scheme and award will be forwarded to the R&R Commissioner. If, the State Government is satisfied with the scheme, the District Administration may issue declaration. AIWTDS will deposit the amount prior to the declaration.

#### c. Disbursement process

The District Administration along with AIWTDS Social experts and officials from Revenue Circle & Gaon Panchayat had organized the consultation meeting with PAPs wherein it was further decided that AIWTDS will disburse the estimated amount to the bank account of the District Administration. A letter requesting for the bank details of the district administration has

also been requested and placed under (*Annexure- 1 E*). The District Administration's office (Land Acquisition branch) will contact the pattadars and possessors since they already have their contact details and bank details and disburse the assistances and compensation to the PAPs and provide us with utilisation certificate accordingly.

#### d. RAP Implementation:

The implementation of RAP is the responsibility of AIWTDS. Social Development Specialist will be responsible for overall coordination with affected persons. AIWTDS shall ensure to release the funds for all the activities as per the agreed plan and approved budgets. It is mandatory to maintain record of expenses and account statements of beneficiaries in order tokeep the overall procedure transparent.

Bachchu Miah, Chief of Dhaka Medical College Hospital's police outpost, told reporters that "the body of a male reached Dhaka Medical College Hospital". He said, "We've come to know that the victim is one of the four people who jumped off the building in a bid to save, themselves from the blaze,"

He added that three other persons are receiving treatment at the hospital in critical condition, Xinhua news agency reported. The fire broke out on the 6th floor of the building, and the inferno subsequently went on to enguli other floors of it.—IANS

The meeting started with a general introduction of the Revenue Officials and AIWTDS Social Team with the Four Pattadars and Six Possessors that were present in the meeting. It was followed by a general discussion upon the importance of the terminal construction at Neamati Ghat.

After discussion amongst the members present, the following issues were noted:

Sl. No.	Discussion/ Decision
1.	While 9 Pattadars are given in the L A estimate provided by Jorhat DC Office, Pattadars for 4 Dag Numbers were only present. Instead of the original Pattadars mentioned in the L A estimate, their descendants (sons and grandsons) represented the original Pattadars as they are no more alive.
2.	The available documents carried by the descendants proving their lineage and connection with their original Pattadars were duly checked by the LA branch officials and found to be authentic in presence of Circle Officer and all other Officials present.
3	The Six possessors mentioned in the LA Estimate were present and also duly checked by aforementioned Officials.
4.	Of Six Possessors, two Possessors viz. Kunju Hazarika and Horulora Das in the LA Estimate have expressed certain discrepancies in their names mentioned in the LA Estimate.  In case of Kunju Hazarika, she claims her name in the identification document is Jumi Hazarika and her pet name is actually Kunju which by mistake was given when the Revenue officials visited.  In case of Horulora Das, the error is regarding one letter only and he claims his name in the identification document is Sarulora Das.  Both of them were advised by the Revenue Officials to get affidavit done to prove the same.
5	Revenue officials informed the Social team of the Society that one Pattadar could not come to the meeting due to some unavoidable circumstances and he was informed by the officials to visit the Circle Office later as per his convenience.


